SUBJECT: Re-Announcement of Summary of Afghan National Defense Security Forces Metrics – Afghan National Police and Afghan National Army
(Project No. D2015-D00SPO-0235.000 formerly D2011-D00SPO-0182)

This is a re-announcement of an ongoing project that relates to an overseas contingency operation (Operation Freedom Sentinel) and will be completed in accordance with the oversight responsibility of the Office of the Inspector General, as described in Section 8L of the Inspector General Act of 1978, as amended. Our objective is to summarize available information relating to the development of an independent and sustainable Afghan National Defense Security Forces (ANSDF). Our intent is to produce consolidated semi-annual products summarizing selected ANSDF metrics, highlighting demonstrated progress and ongoing challenges.

We plan to contact DoD organizations in the United States, the U.S. Central Command area of responsibility, and Afghanistan that are responsible for planning and accomplishing the training, equipping, and fielding mission for the ANSDF. We also plan to contact leaders of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization and partner-nation representatives involved in this process. Site visits from CONUS are not anticipated. We will consider suggestions from management in the preparation of products.
