MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Research on the Development and Transition of Critical Afghanistan National Security Forces Enablers (Project No. D2015-D00SPO-0114.001)

We plan to begin our research effort in January 2015. Its objective is to determine the current status of Afghanistan National Security Forces (ANSF) enabler capabilities and to identify possible Office of the Inspector General (OIG) assessment projects in this area.

We will solicit the views of senior officials and managers at the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics; Commander, U.S. Central Command; and Commander, U.S. Forces – Afghanistan and subordinate commands. Specifically, we intend to conduct interviews with individuals from Resolute Support Headquarters and Combined Security Transition Command – Afghanistan. We will not issue a report from this effort, which will end 120 days after the date on this announcement, but intend to generate an assessment which we will announce separately.

Please provide us with a point of contact for the research project within **10 working days** of the date of this memorandum. The point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15 or the military or pay band equivalent. Send the contact's name, title, grade/pay band, phone number, and e-mail address to SPO@dodig.mil. We will arrange visits to identified organizations through these points of contact.
