SUBJECT: Audit of the Afghan National Police Mentoring/Training and Logistics Support Contract (Project No. D2011-D000AS-0271.000)

We plan to begin the subject audit in August 2011. The audit will be the first in a series of audits on the Afghan National Police Mentoring/Training and Logistics Support contract. Our overall objective for the series of audits is to determine whether DoD officials are using appropriate contracting processes to satisfy mission requirements and are conducting appropriate oversight of the contract in accordance with Federal and DoD policies. For this audit, we will determine whether the Army is appropriately administering the Afghan National Police Mentoring/Training and Logistics Support contract in accordance with Federal and DoD guidance. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the audit at U.S. Army Contracting Command, Aberdeen Proving Ground, in Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland and U.S. Army Contracting Command, Rock Island, Rock Island, Illinois. We may identify additional locations during the audit.
