SUBJECT: Audit of Adequacy of Controls Over Small Arms Contracts for the Afghan National Security Forces (Project No. D2011-D000AT-0246.000)

We plan to begin the subject audit in July 2011. Our overall objective is to evaluate contract award, pricing, and quality assurance provisions for small arms, to include accessories and spare parts, acquired using Afghanistan Security Forces Funds. Specifically, we will determine whether the contract processes were in accordance with applicable acquisition regulations. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the audit at the U.S. Army Security Assistance Command; Defense Logistics Agency; Defense Security Cooperation Agency; U.S. Army Research, Development and Engineering Command; U.S. Army TACOM Life Cycle Management Command; and U.S. Army Contracting Command. We may identify additional locations during the audit; however, we do not anticipate travel to Southwest Asia or contacting officials from the NATO Training Mission-Afghanistan/Combined Security Transition Command-Afghanistan.
