SUBJECT: Assessment of U.S. Efforts to Develop the Afghan National Security Forces Command and Control System (Project No. D2012-D00SPO-0085.000)

We plan to begin our assessment immediately. The objective of this assessment is to determine whether the Department of Defense will complete the development of the Afghan National Security Forces (ANSF) Command and Control System by established end-state dates. Specifically, we will assess whether U.S. Government and Coalition strategy, guidance, plans, and resources are adequate for the development and operational implementation of an effective ANSF Command and Control System.

We plan to visit or contact organizations in the United States and U.S. Central Command area of responsibility that are responsible for developing the Afghan command and control system capability. We plan to visit with the leaders of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization and with partner-nation representatives involved in this process. Specific organizations to be visited will be identified before and during the assessment, and arrangements for those visits will be made through established official points of contact.

Combatant Commands/subordinate organizations listed below are to provide a point of contact for this assessment. The point of contact must be at or above GS-15 civilian grade or O6 military grade.
