SUBJECT: Audit of the Government of Islamic Republic of Afghanistan's Internal Controls for
Asset Accountability (Project No. D2014-D000JB-0219.000)

We plan to begin the subject audit in September 2014. The audit is being conducted in response to a statutory requirement. Our objective is to determine whether the Combined Security Transition Command-Afghanistan (CSTC-A) and the Government of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan's (GIROA) Ministries of Defense and Interior have controls in place to effectively manage asset accountability for vehicles and buildings. Specifically, we will evaluate the adequacy of the policies and procedures for verifying the existence of the donated assets, forecasting of maintenance and replacement operations requirements, and identifying requirements for asset replenishment. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the audit at CSTC-A and the GIROA Ministries of Defense and Interior in Kabul, Afghanistan. We may identify additional locations during the audit.
