We plan to begin the subject audit in April 2015. This project relates to the overseas contingency operation, Operation INHERENT RESOLVE, and will be completed in accordance with the OIG's oversight responsibilities, as described in Section 8L of the Inspector General Act of 1978, as amended. Our objective is to determine whether the Army had effective controls for maintaining property accountability for equipment in Kuwait. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the audit at Camp Arifjan, Kuwait. We may identify additional locations during the audit.
