SUBJECT: Audit of the Army Paladin Integrated Management Program
(Project No. D2016-D000AU-0003.000)

We plan to begin the subject audit in October 2015. The audit will be the first in a series of audits on the Army Paladin Integrated Management Program. Our overall objective for this series of audits is to determine whether the Army is effectively managing the Paladin Integrated Management Program during the production and deployment phase. For this audit, we will evaluate whether program officials justified the low-rate initial production plan and whether test plans and results adequately prepare the program for full rate production. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the audit at the Army Paladin Integrated Management Program Office, Warren, Michigan; the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics, Arlington, Virginia; and the Office of the Director, Operational Test and Evaluation, Arlington, Virginia. We may identify additional locations during the audit.
