We announced the subject audit on November 10, 2015. The objective was to determine whether the Army is accurately accounting for and safeguarding sensitive cargo transported within the U.S. European Command area of responsibility. We are terminating this audit because of ongoing work by the Government Accountability Office. We determined that performing the audit would result in inefficient use of resources.
