SUBJECT: Evaluation of Airborne ISR PED Process for Operation Inherent Resolve (Project No. D2016-DISPA2-0194.000)

We plan to begin the subject Evaluation in August 2016. Our objective is to evaluate whether the OIR Commander's intelligence requirements are being satisfied by the current airborne Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance (ISR) Processing, Exploitation, and Dissemination (PED) process. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the evaluation at selected subordinate components of USCENTCOM, USSTRATCOM, USSOCOM, the National Security Agency, and the Joint Staff. We may identify additional locations during the evaluation.
