SUBJECT: Evaluation of the Separation of Service Members Who Made a Report of Sexual Assault (Project No. 2015C012)

This evaluation is in response to an amendment under H.R. 1735-National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2016, "Inspector General Report on Separation of Members Who Made a Sexual Assault Report." The overall evaluation objective is to identify all service members separated since January 1, 2009, following unrestricted reports of sexual assault, and to evaluate separations for non-disability mental conditions, including personality and adjustment disorder, to determine compliance with guiding policies. The evaluation sub-objectives are to:


- Identify service members who made unrestricted sexual assault reports from January 1, 2009 to June 30, 2015.
- Identify service members by type of separation following unrestricted reports of sexual assault from January 1, 2009 to June 30, 2015.
- Evaluate whether service members separations for non-disability mental conditions, including personality and adjustment disorder, from January 1, 2009 to June 30, 2015, were completed as required by DoD Instruction 1332.14, "Enlisted Administrative Separations," and other guiding regulations, directives, and policies.

We will provide requests for data with detailed parameters by separate correspondence. Because of the NDAA amendment's reporting deadline, data call requests will have correspondingly short deadlines. We appreciate your responding to data call requests with high priority.

Please identify and provide a point of contact knowledgeable of your agency's separation directives, policies, and other guidance relative to the administrative separations of service members by July 10, 2015, to [REDACTED]
