**SUBJECT: Evaluation of AFOSI's Roles and Responsibilities During Internet-Based Operations
(Project No. 2014C018)**

The Office of the Inspector General will evaluate the Air Force Office of Special Investigations' (AFOSI) conduct of internet-based operations and investigations. We will evaluate the procedures used to initiate and participate in internet-based operations and investigations with Federal, state, and civil law enforcement agencies' internet task forces. The overall objective is to determine whether AFOSI has sufficient policy guidance and supervisory oversight covering internet-based operations. Specifically, we will evaluate:

- AFOSI's policy guidance on internet-based operations and investigations;
- AFOSI's policies and procedures for agency participation with Federal, state, and local law enforcement task forces which may include Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) task forces; and
- AFOSI's internet-based investigations, operational plans, Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs), and Memorandums of Agreement (MOAs).
