SUBJECT: Evaluation of U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command Report of Investigation
[REDACTED] (Project No. 2015C001)

This evaluation is in response to a January 23, 2015, inquiry from Senator Mark Warner concerning an U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command's (USACIDC's) response to the Senator's prior inquiry concerning a constituent's complaint. The complaint related to the USACIDC's handling of the constituent's sexual assault allegations against a U.S. Army Reserve member (documented in USACIDC Report of Investigation (ROI) Number [REDACTED]). The evaluation objectives are to determine whether:

- the USACIDC investigation was completed as required by guiding DoD, U.S. Army, and USACIDC policies;
- USACIDC personnel treated the victim with the dignity and respect required by pertinent DoD, U.S. Army, and USACIDC policies.

We will provide a request for data with detailed parameters by separate correspondence. Please identify a point of contact knowledgeable of your agency's adult sexual assault investigative standards, processes, and procedures by February 26, 2015.
