SUBJECT: Summary Report on Inspections of DoD Facilities and Military Housing  
(Project No. D2016-D000PT-0003.000)

We plan to begin the subject project in October 2015. This project will collectively evaluate the results of the previous DoD Office of Inspector General inspections of buildings and housing facilities in Afghanistan, Japan, Korea, and regions of the continental United States, as well as the ongoing facility inspection in Jordan. Our objective is to perform additional analysis based on these reports to identify any potential broader findings and recommendations related to electrical system safety, fire protection systems, environmental health and safety, etc. Specifically, we will evaluate common deficiencies and systemic issues found throughout DoD facilities during the previous inspections. We will also evaluate DoD policy regarding health and safety standards and requirements for DoD-occupied facilities world-wide. We may identify additional locations to perform limited scope inspections of facilities within the regions previously visited, if deemed necessary. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.

Please provide us with points of contact from offices responsible for policy and oversight related to the operation of military facilities, including housing, within **5 days** of the date of this memorandum. All POCs should be a Government employee—an O-6 or GS-15 pay band equivalent, civilian or military.
