SUBJECT: Assessment of U.S. Government and Coalition Efforts to Train, Equip, and Advise the Afghan Border Police (Project No. D2012-D00SPO-0210.000)

We plan to begin this assessment immediately. The objective is to determine whether the planning and operational implementation of efforts by U.S. and Coalition Forces to train, equip, and advise in the development of the Afghan Border Police (ABP) is effective. This includes evaluating output/outcome at ABP locations at various stages of their life cycle to determine the effectiveness of U.S. and Coalition involvement in developing the ABP and Minister of Interior (MoI) ability to manage the program.

We plan to visit or contact organizations and individuals in the continental United States and in the U.S. Central Command area of responsibility that are responsible for developing the ABP. Specific organizations to be visited will be identified before and during the field assessment, and arrangements for those visits will be made through established official points of contact.
