



ABOUT THE HOTLINE

The Defense Hotline provides a confidential means of reporting instances of fraud, waste, abuse of authority, and mismanagement. The Office of Inspector General manages the Defense Hotline.

WHO OPERATES THE HOTLINE?

The Defense Hotline is staffed by professional investigators knowledgeable in military and civilian policies, procedures and regulations; Defense contracting procedures, as well as provisions of agency ethics regulations.

WHO SHOULD CALL THE HOTLINE?

DoD civilian and military personnel, Defense contractor employees, as well as private citizens.

WHEN SHOULD YOU CALL?

Disclosures should be made as soon as information is available. Telephone lines are open Monday - Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Eastern time.



WHAT YOU SHOULD EXPECT

Our primary responsibility is to receive and evaluate your concerns and complaints, and to determine the agency responsible to conduct an inquiry or investigation if appropriate.

We ask that you provide information that will help the investigator piece together the facts of the situation (who, what, when, where, and why) and assess the estimated dollar loss to the government.

An investigator will evaluate your complaint to determine if an investigation is warranted or if you should refer the matter to other authorities.

Calls are handled with confidentiality. You may also call or submit disclosure(s) anonymously.



WHAT SHOULD BE REPORTED

- Whistleblower reprisal
- Contract and procurement fraud
- Cost/labor mischarging
- Computer crimes
- Counterfeit or substandard parts
- Health care fraud
- Product substitution
- Travel or purchase card fraud
- Leaks of classified information
- Trafficking in persons
- Bribery and acceptance of gratuities
- Conflict of interest
- Improper use of DoD resources
