Selection of Principal Deputy Inspector General

Today, the Department of Defense Inspector General Jon T. Rymer announced the selection of Mr. Glenn A. Fine as the Principal Deputy Inspector General for the Office of Inspector General. Mr. Fine will assume his duties on June 1, 2015. Prior to accepting this position, Mr. Fine was a partner at Dechert LLP in the White Collar & Securities Litigation Practice.

Mr. Fine served as the Inspector General of the United States Department of Justice from December 2000 to January 2011. He also served as Special Counsel to the Inspector General and Director of the Special Investigations and Review Unit of the Office of Inspector General of the Department of Justice from 1995-2000.

Mr. Fine graduated with an A.B. in Economics from Harvard College, magna cum laude, and was a Rhodes Scholar at Oxford University where he earned Bachelor of Arts and Masters of Arts degrees. He received his Juris Doctor from Harvard Law School, magna cum laude.
