

Nonconforming Products Procured by the Defense Industrial Supply Center

This audit reported that, overall, the Department of Defense Quality Assurance Program needed improvement. The poor quality of products procured reflected the poor quality controls applied by the contractors who supplied the products. DoD IG estimated that 62 percent of 1.28 billion parts were nonconforming and the Supply Center paid about \$624 million for nonconforming products.
