

Alleged Misconduct by Senior DoD Officials Concerning the Able Danger Program and Lieutenant Colonel Anthony A. Shaffer, U.S. Army Reserve

Allegations concerning Able Danger became public in August 2005 when media sources reported allegations, made by Army Lt. Col. Anthony A. Shaffer, that the identities of terrorists involved in the attack of September 11, 2001 were discovered by Able Danger before the attack, but DoD officials prohibited Able Danger personnel from sharing that information with law enforcement authorities. DoD IG concluded that the anti-terrorist program, Able Danger, did not identify Mohammed Atta or any of the other 9/11 terrorists before the 9/11 attack; nor was Shaffer reprimed against.
