

Audit of Threat Assessment Guidance Regarding Nuclear Weapons Located Outside of the Continental United States

The audit was conducted as part of an audit series examining the physical security of nuclear weapons located outside of the Continental United States. The team developed critical, classified findings regarding compliance with National Security Presidential Directive Number 28 and identified courses of action that will enhance the security of U.S. nuclear weapons. The review determined there were key elements and factors that were not considered when the Nuclear Security Threat Capabilities Assessment development instructions and decisions were made and that implementation without revision could result in DoD not meeting critical mission requirements.
