An assessment team on munitions accountability was sent to Iraq to review the accountability and control of U.S. munitions supplied to the Iraq Security Forces. The team examined U.S. and ISF supply chain operations, following the munitions through transportation, storage and distribution through issuance to individual Iraqi soldiers and police officers. The purpose was to eliminate the loss of weapons into the possession of terrorist and criminals.
