

## *Assessments of Wounded Warrior Matters*

### 2011-2012

In 2007/2008, the Army and Marine Corps established Warrior Care and Transition programs to evaluate the recovery of seriously wounded, ill and injured personnel from Operations Iraqi and Enduring Freedom receiving long-term out-patient care. Field assessments have been conducted at Fort Sam Houston, Texas; Fort Drum, N.Y.; Camp Lejeune, N.C.; Camp Pendleton, CA.; Fort Riley, KS; and Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Wash. A number of problems have been identified, including the insufficient availability of specialty medical care and a lack of program support for warriors preparing to transition to civilian life.



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
